A BILL

- To limit funding to the United Nations until the Islamic Republic of Iran has been expelled and investigated for violations of the Genocide Convention, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "U.N. Anti-Terrorism
- 5 Accountability Act of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. OPPOSITION OF IRAN AT THE UNITED NATIONS.
2	The United States Permanent Representative to the
3	United Nations shall use the voice, vote, and influence of
4	the United States at the United Nations—
5	(1) to urge member states to expel the Islamic
6	Republic of Iran from the United Nations General
7	Assembly; and
8	(2) to encourage member states to investigate
9	potential violations by the Islamic Republic of Iran
10	of the Convention on the Prevention and Punish-
11	ment of the Crime of Genocide, adopted at Paris
12	December 9, 1948 (commonly known as the "Geno-
13	cide Convention").
14	SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON FUNDING FOR THE UNITED NA
15	TIONS.
16	The United States may not make any voluntary or
17	involuntary contributions to the United Nations Relief and
18	Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East
19	until the Secretary of State certifies to Congress that the
20	Islamic Republic of Iran—
21	(1) has been expelled from the United Nations
22	General Assembly; and
23	(2) is being investigated for violations of the
24	Genocide Convention.
